## **SECAT is back with \$8 million reasons to apply!**

**Beginning September 1, 2008 the Sacramento Emergency Clean Air Transportation (SECAT) Program will make the following changes:**

- 1. \$8 million is available for new projects towards purchasing 2007-emission compliant diesel trucks operating in Sacramento, Placer, Yolo, El Dorado, southern Sutter, and northeastern Solano Counties**
- 2. All Pre-1994 heavy-duty diesel vehicles (registered weight over 14,000 lbs GVWR) operating in the Sacramento region are eligible**
- 3. Vocational trucks—including 10-wheel dump, mixer, water, and crane trucks—can qualify for funding using engine hours of operation**
- 4. Funding per vehicle will be capped at the minimum of either:  
**\$50,000 per vehicle; or**  
**50% of the vehicle invoice price (excluding ineligible costs); or**  
**The maximum amount meeting \$100,000/1-yr ton NOx****
